

Course Descriptions

RT-130 Annual Safety Review - Annual Fireline Safety Refresher Training should be designed to provide up to date fireline safety information to employees holding Incident Command System Qualifications red cards requiring this training. Safety Refresher Training should contain content pertinent to the registered students. **Prerequisites - FFT2 or THSP**

NSA 40 Basic 1st Aid / CPR—Basic First Responder administering basic 1st aid and CPR.
Course Prerequisites — none

S-131— Fire Fighter Type 1—Course designed to meet the training needs of the Fire Fighter Type 1 (FFT1). This course is designed to be interactive in nature. It contains several tactical decision games designed to facilitate learning the objective and class discussion. Topics include fireline reference materials, communications, and tactical decision making. **Course Prerequisites: >> FFT2**

S-130 /190 Firefighting Training - This introductory course is designed to train entry-level firefighters referred to as a firefighter type 2 (FFT2) . Students will be introduced to and gain knowledge of the basic incident management organization, firefighting techniques, suppression equipment, safety, strategy / tactics along with fire behavior. Field exercises will be performed for valuable hands-on training. Includes L-180 and I-100. **Course Prerequisites: >> IS-700**

S-212 Wildland Fire Chainsaws— This is an instructor-led course intended to be presented at the local level. The course lessons provide introduction to the function, maintenance, and use of internal combustion engine powered chainsaws and their tactical wildland fire application. Field exercises support entry level training for firefighters with little or no previous experience in operating a chainsaw, providing hands-on cutting experience in surroundings similar to fire line situations. Certification is based on individuals field evaluation performance **Course Prerequisites: » FFT2**

S-219 Firing Operations—This course introduces the roles and responsibilities of a Firing Boss (FIRB) and outlines duties of other personnel who may engage firing operations. The course discusses and illustrates common firing devices and techniques. Although comprehensive in nature, the course work is not a substitute for the dynamic fire environment . The course provides students with important information regarding general tasks required to be successful. **Course Prerequisites :>> FFT1 (t)**

S-231 Engine Boss (Single Resource) - This a skill course designed to produce student proficiency in the performance of the duties associated with Engine Boss, single resource (ENGB). Topics include engine and crew capabilities and limitations, information sources, fire size-up considerations, tactics, and wildland/urban interface. **Course Prerequisites: >> FFT1**

L-280 Followership to Leadership— This course is designed as a self-assessment opportunity for individuals preparing to step into a leadership role. The course combines one day of classroom instruction followed by a second day in the field with students working through a series of problem solving events in small teams (Field Leadership Assessment Course). Topics include leadership values and principles, transition challenges for new leaders, situational leadership, team cohesion factors, ethical decision making, and after action review techniques. **Course Prerequisites: >> FFT1 (t)**

UTVO— This course will cover the safety, driving maneuverability's and capabilities of operating Utility Terrain Vehicles in the work field. Successful completion of the course will allow student to have UTVO job code on IQCS red card. **Course Prerequisite: >> ASI online safety course.**
